


World Environment Day

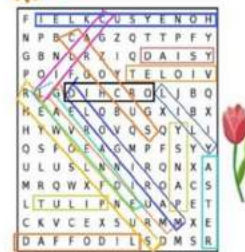
